EQUESTRIAN AND FARM FEEDS/NISA CLYDESDALE CHAMPIONSHIP 2022

NOTE: Exhibitors must include Name of Animal on Entry Form for Classes in NISA Clydesdale Championship.

Points will be awarded for animals placed – 1st – 5 points, 2nd – 4 points and 3rd – 3 points in the eligible Clydesdale Classes at this Show.

In addition all horses forward in a Class will be awarded one point. These points, together with those gained at other NISA Member Shows staging Clydesdale Classes during the 2022 Show Season, will be totalled but where more than one Show (having Heavy Horse Classes) takes place on the same day, points gained will only count from one of these Shows. Exhibitors must include the name of their Animal(s) on the Entry Form. Trophies will be awarded to the Exhibitors of the 6 highest placed horses.

**Class A1: CLYDESDALE OR AGRICULTURAL TYPE
BROOD MARE**

Having produced a Foal, with Foal at Foot or due to foal, before 31 August 2022. Eligible for points in EQUESTRIAN AND FARM FEEDS/NISA Clydesdale Championship 2022. AGRICULTURAL TYPE HORSES

**Class A2: CLYDESDALE OR AGRICULTURAL TYPE
FOAL**

**Class A3: CLYDESDALE OR AGRICULTURAL TYPE
GELDING OR FILLY**

1 year old. Eligible for points in EQUESTRIAN AND FARM FEEDS/NISA Clydesdale Championship 2022

**Class A4: CLYDEDALE OR AGRICULTURAL TYPE
GELDING OR FILLY, 2 years old.**

(If insufficient entries in Classes 3 and 4, Classes will be amalgamated.) Eligible for points in EQUESTRIAN AND FARM FEEDS/NISA Clydesdale Championship 2022

**Class A5: CLYDEDALE OR AGRICULTURAL TYPE
GELDING OR MARE, 3 years and upward.**

Eligible for points in EQUESTRIAN AND FARM FEEDS/NISA Clydesdale Championship 2022.

Class A6: RIDDEN CLYDESDALE, any age or sex.

Riders must be at least 16 years old.

**Class A7: GENERAL PURPOSE TYPE GELDING OR
MARE, 2 years old and upward.**

Eligible for points in EQUESTRIAN AND FARM FEEDS/NISA Clydesdale Championship 2022.

Class A8: YOUNG HANDLERS, 12 to 16 years old

Class A9: WHEELED CLASS.

This Class will be shown in Main Cattle Arena in afternoon.

**Class A10: ANY 4 WHEEL CARRIAGE OR TRAP FOR
STYLE AND APPEARANCE, driven by any breed of
horse**

This Class will be shown in Main Cattle Arena in afternoon.
